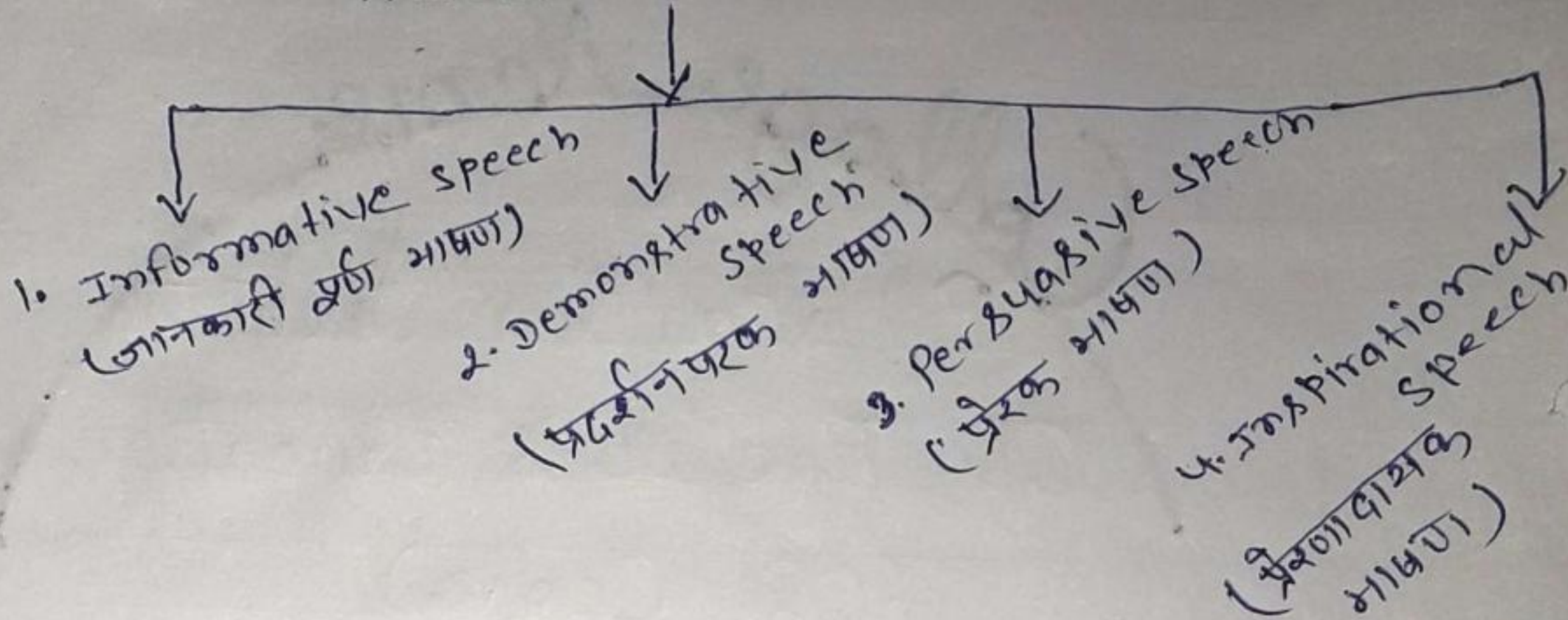

1. Informative speech: An informative speech is one that intends to educate the audience on a particular topic, providing knowledge, especially useful or interesting information.

These are the most common type of presentation and are used to present. This type of speech uses description, demonstration and definition to explain a subject, person, or place the audience wants to understand.

2. Demonstrative speech: Make the topic of your speech relevant to your audience by

This speech can take on topics ranging from the newest, high-tech inventions from around the world. The topic should be one that is timely and interesting.

3. Persuasive speech ÷ A persuasive speech is a specific type of speech in which the speaker has a goal of convincing the audience to accept his or her point of view. The speech is arranged in such a way as to hopefully cause the audience to accept all or part of the expressed view.

For example - sales pitch (after effort) During sales pitch, the speaker is trying to convince the audience to buy his product or service.

4. Inspirational speech: An inspirational speech does not need the audience to take action. Its intention is to create an uplifting emotional experience that leaves the audience feeling inspired.

The goal of a motivational speech is to motivate an audience to take a specific action, usually in regard to personal or professional growth.
