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Word formation (using prefixes and suffixes)

Prefix : A prefix is a letter or a group of letter attached to the beginning of a word to form a new word.

In simple words, a prefix is a few letters put at the beginning of a word to change its meaning

Example:-

- un - unhappy, universal unicycle

- Tri - triangle, tripod, tricycle
- Super - superfood, superstar

Suffix & suffix are used to make new words and gives base words different meaning. suffix are added to the end of words to make new words.

Example:

- father - father
- flipped - flipped
- muddy - muddy
- stepped - stepped
- swimming - swimming
